

ORGANO-CHARACTERS

WHAT ARE WE GOING TO DO?

With this activity we will learn about the organs of our body playing with the organo-characters. In addition, we will design some cards with the characteristics of each one and then we will test our knowledge, playing to associate them with the organo-characters.

WHAT MATERIAL ARE WE GOING TO NEED?

- A blank sheet or colored sheets (remember that if it is recycled the better!)
- A black marker
- A pencil
- Colored pencils (you can also use crayons, markers or watercolors)
- Scissors

STEPS TO FOLLOW:

1. Draw 12 rectangles or squares on the white sheet or choose the colored sheets you want. The rectangles will be the cards with which we will play.
2. 6 cards will correspond to 6 organs of our body (they will be the organ characters). Draw an organ on each card: Kidneys, Lungs, Spleen, Heart, Brain, Liver.
3. 6 cards will correspond to the characteristics of each of the organs. Write on each card the characteristics of each one of them.
4. Cut them out.
5. You can play to recognize the organs and know their characteristics and then, the next level, match them!
