

# THE LIFE CYCLE OF FROGS

## WHAT ARE WE GOING TO DO?

We are going to draw the life cycle of a frog to learn how they grow from being eggs until they become adults. Did you know that they go through 3 different stages of development? Embryonic phase (eggs and embryos), metamorphosis phase (tadpoles) and adult phase (adult frog). With the use of a cord we are going to unite each of the phases of development that we have drawn and while we will learn what they are. You can play repeat this several times!

## WHAT MATERIAL ARE WE GOING TO NEED?

- A square or rectangle piece of cardboard (remember that if it is recycled the better!)
- Colored pencils (you can also use crayons, markers or watercolors)
- A punch (you can also use a crochet hook or a worn ballpoint pen)
- Ropes or laces

## STEPS TO FOLLOW:

1. Cut out your piece of cardboard.
2. Draw the life cycle of the frog going through its 3 stages of development.
3. Color your drawing.
4. Make holes to join the different stages of development of the frog using the rope or cord.
5. Insert the cord through each hole as you go through the stages of development. (Remember: embryonic phase, metamorphosis phase and adult phase).
