

WHAT KIND OF QUERCUS AM I?

WHAT ARE WE GOING TO DO?

We are going to draw the leaves of three species of the Quercus genus and we will also design some cards with the characteristics of each species. Then we will play to associate the cards of the characteristics with the leaf of each species. Did you know that the name of Quercus was given by the Romans? Quercus is used to refer to oaks in general, acorn-producing trees.

The three species that we will see will be: the oak (*Quercus ilex*), the cork oak (*Quercus suber*) and the kelp (*Quercus coccifera*). The Mediterranean climate is characterized by having dry summers and frost winters, these species have developed certain adaptations to withstand these conditions.

WHAT MATERIAL ARE WE GOING TO NEED?

- 6 clothes pegs
- White sheets (remember that if it is recycled the better!)
- A black marker
- or a pencil
- Colored pencils (you can also use crayons, markers or watercolors)
- A scissor
- Adhesive tape

STEPS TO FOLLOW:

1. Draw the leaves of the three Quercus species.
2. Design the cards as you like and add the characteristics of each of the species.
3. Create small posters with the names of the species and attach them to the clothespins.
4. Now you can start playing!
