WHAT ARE WE GOING TO DO?

We are going to learn what a food chain is and what it is made of. We will prepare a pyramid in which we will place four links of a trophic chain and we will play to recognize them by means of some labels with the names. These links will be the Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Consumers and the Producers.

WHAT MATERIAL ARE WE GOING TO NEED?

- 1 blank page (remember that if it is recycled the better!)
- A black marker
- A pencil
- Colored pencils (you can also use crayons, markers or watercolors)
- A scissor
- Adhesive tape
- A rule
- Two wooden sticks

STEPS TO FOLLOW:

1. We draw a triangle on the blank page, it will represent the trophic pyramid.
2. We will make four divisions.
3. In each section we will draw the organisms that are representative of each level in the trophic pyramid.
4. Color the different organisms you have drawn.
5. Design four cards that contain the names of each link: Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Consumers and Producers.
6. Cut out and associate the cards with the level of the trophic pyramid to which they belong.
7. Tape each level of the pyramid to the wooden sticks with the adhesive tape.
8. When everything is ready, you can hang it anywhere!
